Extension of benefits available under the Canada Recovery Benefit (CRB), the Canada Recovery Sickness Benefit (CRSB), the Canada Recovery Caregiving Benefit (CRCB) and El regular benefits

Background:

In 2020, the DNSSAB issued Housing Services Notices to housing providers who administer both Provincial rent-geared-to-income (RGI) and Federal rent-to-income (RTI) on how to deal with new federal benefits available to tenants due to the COVID-19 pandemic. These benefits included the Canada Recovery Benefit (CRB), the Canada Recovery Sickness Benefit (CRSB), the Canada Recovery Caregiving Benefit (CRCB) and EI regular benefits.

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The Federal government has now provided an update, through Sevice Canada, on the extension of benefits available under these programs.

Action:

Please see the update attached (in French and English) from Service Canada explaining the extensions of benefits available under the Canada Recovery Benefit (CRB), the Canada Recovery Sickness Benefit (CRSB), the Canada Recovery Caregiving Benefit (CRCB) and El regular benefits.

Housing providers are directed to continue to use the methodology described in HSN 2020-08 (Provincial Providers) and HSN 2020-11 (Federal Providers) for the administration RGI and RTI rent calculations.
